## **TRAVEL TIPS**

### **AIRPORT TRANSFER**

#### **Arrival in Munich**

Munich Airport (MUC) is approximately 20–25 minutes by car from the INFINITY Hotel.

You can reach the hotel via:

- Taxi
- Uber / Bolt / FreeNow
- S-Bahn (Local train) + taxi combination

#### **Taxi Information**

Taxis are available directly outside the arrivals terminal.

Approximate taxi cost to the hotel:

€45–€65 depending on traffic.

#### **Public Transport**

You can take the S-Bahn (S1 or S8) toward Munich, to the stop “Unterschleißheim” and connect via taxi/local transport to the hotel. All options with public transport do involve some walking. Train connections on Google Maps are accurate.

## **WEATHER**

June in Munich is generally warm and pleasant, though weather can change quickly.

Expect:

- Warm sunny afternoons
- Cooler mornings and evenings
- Occasional summer rain showers

We recommend bringing:

1. Comfortable walking shoes (For the excursions on Wednesday & Saturday)
2. A light jacket or sweater
3. An umbrella or light rain jacket
4. Sunglasses and sunscreen (For the excursions on Wednesday & Saturday)
